



Airplane SEL Private Pilot Course

Length of training course will be in accordance with student's availability.
 Normal course length takes 6 months

Example # 1 - FAA Minimums:

- 40 Hours Flight Time
- 40 Hours Ground & Flight Instruction w/ a Certified Flight Instructor (CFI)

Pay-as-you-Go Total = \$8,400

Cessna 172 or Cherokee 180: \$150 per hour
 CFI: \$60 per hour

OR

Pre-Pay Rate Total = \$7,800

\$3,000 payments required as you train (cash or check)
 Cessna 172 or Cherokee 180: \$140 per hour
 CFI: \$55 per hour

Example #2 - Realistic Goal:

- 60 Hours Flight Time
- 80 Hours Ground & Flight Instruction w/ a Certified Flight Instructor (CFI)

Pay-as-you-Go Total = \$13,800

Cessna 172 or Cherokee 180: \$150 per hour
 CFI: \$60 per hour

OR

Pre-Pay Rate Total = \$12,800

\$3,000 payments required as you train (cash or check)
 Cessna 172 or Cherokee 180: \$140 per hour
 CFI: \$55 per hour

(National average for private pilot certification is approximately 65 hours flight time)

- **FAA Course Minimum hours required is 40 flight hours.**
- **Book package recommended for this course is \$150. (Additional online ground school recommended)**
- **FAA exams and renters insurance are not included in package pricing.**
 - **FAA written exam is \$160**
 - **Renters insurance is \$150**
 - **Designated Pilot Examiner Fee for the Practical Exam (checkride) ranges from \$600-\$800**
- **Stage checks are billed at \$80 per hour CFI time instead of \$60 per hour**
 - **We conduct 3 stage checks during your Private Pilot Course so allow an extra \$100 in your budget for each stage check (\$300 total).**
- **These packages do not guarantee your private pilot certification as it depends on individual proficiency.**
- **Rates subject to change at any time due to changing fuel and maintenance costs.**
